**THE NEW INVESTIGATOR AWARD** was presented to Timothy Butterfield, PhD, ATC.

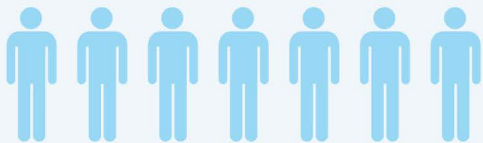
**THE STUDENT WRITING CONTEST** named two new winners in 2013, Chyrsten Regelski and Dierdre Chatlos.
